Members:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Cannot have been convicted of any offence pertaining to animal welfare.
- Must provide accurate information on their Membership forms.
- Must comply with MHS Bylaws.
- Must behave in an ethical and respectful manner and follow the **Ontario Human Rights Code** while attending any MHS function, meetings or within the property of partner locations.
- Will demonstrate compassion, respect, and responsible communication when conducting oneself online via social media, digital communications, or otherwise, and will choose compassion over criticism in online discussions related to MHS and its digital platforms.
- Must conduct oneself with integrity and honesty while representing MHS, including not misrepresenting oneself: falsifying or fabricating information, either through omission or commission; or knowingly circulating false or misleading information.
